

Para Chess



Chess is a strategy game played by two players using chess board comprises of 64 squares (eight rows and eight columns) set in two colors. Athletes will be competing against each other using strategies to win the game.

To win the game, players need to move their pieces based on the rules, and captured opponents' pieces, if possible to force the checkmate to claim the win. Other than checkmate, the winner can be decided if the rival resigns from the game, usually because of hopeless position of pieces.

The Sport will be divided into two categories, standard chess and rapid chess.
