MS NOOR SYAHIEDA BINTI MAT SHAH is one of the Vice President of Paralympic Council Malaysia elected on 14th December 2019. She is the Chairperson of Women Leadership Committee responsible to bring about advancement of women involvement in Paralympic Movement in the country. She was also a Vice President of Malaysia Para Powerlifting Association till 2022.

Ms Noor involvement with Paralympic Movement dates back to 2009 when she was employed at PCM as an Event Executive. She is a World Para Powerlifting (WPPO) Educator since 2017 and also serves in the WPPO Education & Development Advisory Board of the International Paralympic Committee on a voluntary basis.

Ms Noor obtained all her 3 academic qualifications from Universiti Teknologi MARA – Diploma in Office Management & Technology 2007, Bachelor of Event Management (Hons) in 2009 and Master in Tourism Management in 2012. She currently serves as a Senior Lecturer in the Department of International Business & Management Studies, Faculty of Business & Management, UiTM.

The Executive Board of PCM made a historic decision by selecting Ms Noor as Chef de Mission, as this was the first time a female has been given the responsibility to lead the country's Para-Sports Contingent to a multi-sports game like ASEAN Para Games. This is in line with our aspirations to bring about gender equality in our Paralympic Movement. She will be assisted by **En Mohd Azhari Bin Mohammad** (ACdM) who is the Director General of Department of Youth & Sports (JBS) of the Ministry of Youth & Sports Malaysia.
